

Alessandro Agostini: With a background in environmental science, Alessandro has been working on environmental impacts of energy and transport system for the last 20 years. For 7 years (2009-2015) he was detached national expert at the Joint Research Centre on the European Commission, where he focused on bioenergy sustainability. He was fully engaged, in providing the scientific evidence to the policy DGs for the definition of the sustainability criteria and the calculation of the default and typical values for the update of the Renewable Energy Directive.
