

Dr. **Dora Mehn** is a project officer at the Consumer Products Safety Unit of the European Commission's Joint Research Centre (Ispra, Italy). She earned her degree as a teacher of Biology and Chemistry (1997) and her PhD in Environmental Chemistry (2002) from the University of Szeged (Hungary). After post-doctoral fellowships at the University of Namur (Belgium) and at the University of Szeged (nanoparticle synthesis and characterization) she joined Solvo Biotechnology (Szeged, Hungary, 2005-2008, head of the fee for service screening laboratory). After 3 years at the Joint Research Centre (Ispra, Italy, 2008-2011, grantholder) and 2.5 years at the Fondazione Don Gnocchi (Milan, Italy, researcher) she became an official of the European Commission in 2014.
