Pierangelo Metrangolo is full professor at Politecnico di Milano. He also holds positions as visiting professor at the VTT-Technical Research Centre of Finland and at the Aalto University, Finland, where he also chairs the local UNESCO/UNITWIN Chair "GREENOMIcS-GReen chEmistry ExcelleNce from Baltic Sea tO MedIterranean Sea and beyond".

His recent awards include the 2021 Giorgio Modena medal of the Italian Chemical Society and the 2019 Fluorous Technologies Award.

He is author of 290 publications with 19528 citations (H-index: 63).

Since 2013 he is being European Research Council (ERC) grantee with the projects "FOLDHALO – Folding with Halogen Bonding" and "MINIRES – A Minimalist Peptide Elastomer", aimed at investigating the relevance of biomolecular halogen bonds. He is the 2022-2023 President of the Physical and Biophysical Chemistry Division (DIV. I) of the IUPAC.
